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Readers are going to be shocked by some of these scores, but these releases from Chateau Pesquié are the real deal! Along with Domaine de Fondrèche, I consider this estate the leader in terms of quality in the Ventoux, and it's also one of the oldest estates in the appellation, with history going back to the late 1700s.[...] It's been run with superstar talent since 2003 by the Chaudiere family's two sons, Alexandre and Frédéric.

For this retrospective, we focused primarily on two cuvées, the Ventoux Cuvee Artemia and the Ventoux la Quintessence.

These are both beautiful, age-worthy wines that show the potential of this up-and-coming appellation!

## ARTEMIA, 2007 97/100

The 2007 Ventoux Cuvee Artemia is the greatest wine I've tasted from the estate, and the appellation! A wine that would stand toe to toe with some of the greatest Chateauneuf du Papes out there.

## QUINTESSENCE, 2010 95/100

Given its purity, structure and still youthful character, this impressive Syrah will see its 20th birthday in fine form.
